
MAP 3. Nonmetropolitan Micropolitan Statistical Areas Central Place is <u>in</u> Kentucky and has population 11,000 or more in 2010


MAP 4. Nonmetropolitan Micropolitan Statistical Areas Central Place is in Kentucky and has population 9-11,000 in 2010


MAP 5. Nonmetropolitan Micropolitan Statistical Areas Central Place is in Kentucky and has population less than 9,000 in 2010









Metro Area Growth

Metropolitan Area Growth 2010-2014




Population Change - Actual











- Partnerships: The manner in which Extension collaborates and builds effective partnerships to leverage resources for collective impact.
