Recommendations from CDC:

- Emphasize staying home when sick, respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene by all employees (and volunteers).
- Perform routine environmental cleaning of workstations, countertops, doorknobs
 - NO ADDITIONAL DISINFECTION BEYOND ROUTINE CLEANING
 - Provide disposable wipes for commonly used surfaces can be wiped down by employees before use

- The UK account manager now requires 2FA in addition to Linkblue username
 - This works just like the MyUK 2FA
 - Expect more things to use 2FA in the future
- New employees will need to use
 https://newemployee.uky.edu/Account/NewEmployee in order to activate
 - their account since they won't be able to log into the account manager



- Beginning in October, some email programs will no longer work with Office
 365
 - If you are using a Windows or Mac machine, we recommend using Outlook from Office 365 to connect to your email
 - If you are using an Android or iOS device, we recommend using the Outlook app instead of the default mail app
 - It is free
 - Includes mail and calendar just like Outlook for Win/Mac
 - I would go ahead and switch now to get used to it





- Expect more security updates in the coming months
 - More sites will start using 2FA to help reduce unauthorized access
 - Discussing policy changes to match some of main campus' policies
 - One examples of what is being discussed is requiring that all machines be locked after 30 min of inactivity

PHISHING

- Be careful about what links you click in emails
- Report any spam using the "report message" button in the upper right corner of Outlook
 - Let me know if you get one that you aren't sure about
- UKITS to implement a warning system from any email coming from a non-UK email address
 - Already testing with pilot users, so should be soon



Bulk Mail/Satori changes

- The contract with Satori will end on June 30.
- As a result, the bulk mailing process will transfer to the county level, rather than be negotiated on a statewide basis.
- Counties will need to budget accordingly and start assessing other options that would be a good fit for their individual situations.
- District IT Techs will remove Satori from county computers as the contract is complete.

- The contract for first class mail meters will end in late 2021 and this will be reviewed closer to that time.



Plan of Work

- Counties should have POW meetings with councils/volunteers completed ideally by the end of March.
- Agents should first meet with Program Councils to provide overview of the Plan of Work Process (resources can be found on the PSD website).
- Agents should remind program councils of the community assessment reports and that these are resources to use for POW discussions/meetings.
- After the program councils have finalized priority areas, these issues/program ideas should be presented to the County Extension Council.



Plan of Work...continued

- Agents should work with the County Extension Council to determine what programs will remain program area specific and those that will be collaborative efforts among agents.
- Agents should reiterate how the community assessment can enhance the Plan of Work process.
- Agents should also work with councils/volunteers to determine best practices to market these programs to effectively make the community aware, increase participation, recruit new audiences, etc.
